<u>The AVM welcomes (The Rev. Canon Dr.) John A. Macdonald</u> <u>onto its executive board</u>

(The Rev. Canon Dr.) John A. Macdonald is the Director of the Stanway Institute for World Mission and Evangelism and Associate Professor of Mission and Evangelism and at Trinity School for Ministry, Ambridge. He is also an ordained minister in the Anglican Church in North America.



Dr. Macdonald received his B.A. in English (Hons.) from Dickinson College, Carlisle, PA, and has attended Trinity College, Bristol, England, and the Unversité de Rennes, France. He was awarded the M.Div. from Trinity Episcopal School for Ministry in 1986 and the D.Miss. from Fuller Theological Seminary in 2011.

Prior to joining the Faculty at Trinity School for Ministry, Dr. Macdonald had five years of parish ministry in the United States, before returning to Honduras with his family as missionaries with the then South American Missionary Society. In Honduras, He was the team leader for an ambitious

church planting project in Tegucigalpa, then served as Canon for Evangelism for the Episcopal Diocese of Honduras, and then he was Dean of the Catedral El Buen Pastor in San Pedro Sula.

He has preached and taught in five continents and has an insatiable desire to talk about the Church's mission. He co-authored with Francisco Guardado *Evangelismo en la Iglesia Local* and is the author of the children's fantasy novel *Pachunga*. He has also published a number of journal and popular articles on evangelism and mission.
