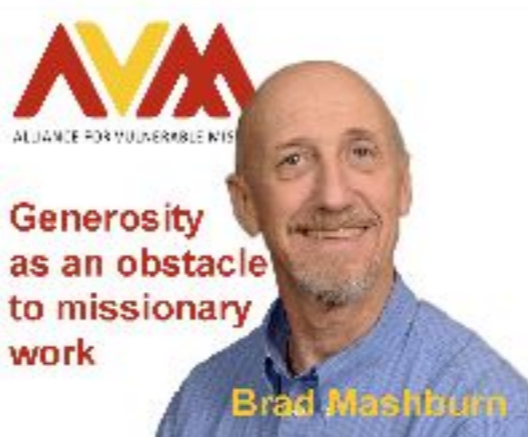

The Alliance for Vulnerable Mission encourages some missionaries from the West to engage in their ministries using local languages and resources.



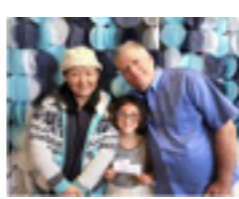

In the July 2022 edition of Global Connections Network News, CEO Harvey Kwiyani presented that the Board of Trustees invites further discussion on the historical relationship between mission, colonialism, and race as they believe it will be a central issue as the next generations of missionaries emerge throughout the world. The URL points to a Global Connections Board statement on the same issue.

This assessment seems accurate as new missionaries often must break through barriers created by the world's missionary past. However, I, Daniel Albert, feel that, as most of the missionaries of the next generation will come from non-Western countries, there will be a sense of liberation within these future missionaries as they break from our historical past.
