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Introductory : Preparatory work, definition, scope of the report, religious education and the Gospel.

The Problem : The new contact of peoples, the revolt against authority, the scientific attitude toward life, national systems of education, the challenge to the Church, the need for a new vision of God, outline of the report.

Significant Tendencies in Modern Education : Concern with persons, original human nature, the process of learning, the growth of the self, the influence of the natural world and of things, the social nature of education, education for community life, education for change, the problem of values, education and religion, the teacher.

Education in the Light of the Christian Purpose : The Christian concern with persons, salvation, revelation, life, worship, the will of God, the service of man, trust in God, the Christian fellowship, the struggle with sin, conversion, the Holy Spirit, education and the Christian purpose.

The Practice of Religious Education ; Education through Christian living, through Christian worship, through Christian teaching, the study of the Bible, present shortcomings in curricula and syllabuses, the project method in religious education, the home, the school, the church, the community.

The Relation of Christian Education to National Systems.

Practical Issues : A new adventure in Christian living, review of present policies and practice, need for continued thought and inquiry, need for experiment and observation, the training of indigenous workers, the training of missionaries, supervision, curricula and syllabuses, fellowships

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
