Now with the experience of failures in the past, and with this magnificent opportunity before the Church to-day, we have an open door for the evangelization of India such as the Church has never seen in its history before. Literally anything may happen if the harvest is reaped, and the tens of thousands may be hundreds of thousands to-morrow, and millions in a few years' time.

The facts I have given in this article I have taken care to verify, and they are not exaggerated. I have brought them together to present to the Church at home the challenge of all God is doing in India. Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest to send forth more reapers into His harvest.

Atheism in the Kindergarten

An article in the Russian paper, Anti-religioznic, on 'Anti-religious education in schools,' says, 'With all our great success in our propaganda against religious thought and to bring our country into a condition of atheism, religion still holds many millions of our workers, especially in the villages, and a great number of our children are still under the influence of religious ideals. The children, thus, have still to get the poison of religion out of their hearts. . . I visited 129 preparatory schools in the Saratov and Moscow districts and cross-examined the children. The results of this inquiry were that our seven to eight year old children are completely free from the superstition connected with the consciousness of a God. None of these children pray at home or in church. No such satisfactory result have been obtained in other countries. It can only exist in a socialistic country, and a socialistic country which has established a new life, without God or priest or capitalist.

'Here are some answers of eight year old children: "I know nothing of God, there is no God"; "Grandmother speaks of God, I do not believe"; "I have never heard of a God"; "I do not pray, what have I to be afraid of?" Great check must be placed on the homes and the parents to see that no religious education be brought into play.'
