Until to-day, the Gospel, generally speaking, has only reached the poorer and uneducated classes, but now there are hundreds of children of Christian parents studying in the secondary schools and the universities who give promise of greater things for the coming days. How necessary it becomes to give careful attention to their spiritual needs, so that, as they grow in knowledge, their faith and consecration may not be dimmed. Much may be expected also from the Sunday-schools. An ever-increasing multitude of children, growing up under the influence of God's Word, are already opening up new opportunities for work among young people.

Christian youth is, at the present moment, merely like the grain of mustard seed in the parable, or like a little leaven. Will it become a great tree under whose branches the fine and promising youth of this land will find shelter? Will the day come when all the meal will be leavened? As our thoughts turn to the Christ who is able to regenerate the life and win the heart of youth, so our eyes close in prayer that we may be worthy of labouring together with Him in such a gigantic enterprise.

Alarming Facts

In May of this year a world Atheistic Conference was held in Moscow and was attended by delegates of thirty-six countries. It was determined to take up an aggressive attitude everywhere to religion, especially to the Christian religion. To achieve this end, it was resolved to create an international Atheistic Fund for the purpose of organizing worldwide propaganda. Summer camps of the Revolutionary Communists in the U.S.A. reached over 20,000 children this summer, and organizations are specially active in the schools and colleges. The major industries have been penetrated by 'cells' and a definite programme aiming at armed revolution has been prepared and published.

Only about one-third of the children of the world are in Christian Sunday-schools, although the number of scholars has increased everywhere in the last four years *except in the older Christian countries*. Communist Sunday-schools are steadily increasing.
