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Conclusion.

It is not from idealism that we have been led to affirm the possibility of this comprehension in which colonials and foreign missionaries can collaborate within the limits of the nation in the great work of human fraternity. Rather it is as a result of studying the history of a suzerain colonial nation that we have seen the significance of the long spiritual effort which has permitted French Protestantism to live. and France to be a country of religious liberty. missionary can penetrate the history of this struggle. perceive its underlying meaning, and draw from it ideas helpful to the native dependent upon a European sovereignty. Circumstances may be different from those we have noticed in French history, but missionary discipline remains the same. As he penetrates the mentality of a country and sympathetically understands the people among whom he works, he is better able to make himself 'all things to all men' and to bring all things into captivity to the obedience of Christ.
