rival programmes. ### A Tactical Blunder

The pictures that are arriving from the Far East, showing helpless Chinese men, women and little children, with an agony of fear on their faces, fleeing in terror, are followed by other pictures showing rejoicing crowds in Japan. A word-picture of the horrors of ruthless modern warfare described a scene in Abyssinia which was unforgettable: 'Swooping aeroplanes, and mothers lying bleeding to death beside the bodies of shattered children.' To-day Japan, with similar weapons, is creating fathomless depths of hatred in the hearts of the Chinese and is earning the moral opprobrium of the world.

'The Prince of the power of the air' has prostituted human progress to ends of wellnigh unbelievable horror, and has persuaded Japan to commit what the *Infantry Journal* calls a 'tactical blunder,' by bombing defenceless people. Japan's Asiatic policy is being pursued with merciless ferocity, and the reaction upon Japan and the Japanese will, in some form or other, prove the truth of the words, 'With what measure ye mete it shall be measured to you again.' We are seeing something new in the realm of diabolical war, pursued without the declaration of war by soldiers with bravery unexcelled, who will gird themselves against barriers which are holding up the progress of the army; by displays of courage and loyalty almost without parallel which, if called forth by higher ideals and displayed in other ways, would be an immense constructive force in human progress.

Much of the Press of to-day shows how unchristian the world is. One country or group of countries vilifies others and rejoices in any sign of their discomfiture or weakness, 'rejoicing in iniquity,' as the Old Book puts it. Hatred of love, will, if it goes on unchecked, result in murder on a world scale and then in the suicide of the murderers.

A few Japanese Christians some time ago, sat down with some Chinese Christians for conference and mutual comfort. If it were possible for this to take place on a national scale, any justifiable objective could be attained without bloodshed and waste of wealth! Unjustifiable objectives are but 'Apples of Sodom.'
