The burden on the heart of God is the evangelization of the world and the preparation of the Church of Christ for His Coming; not the political destinies of godless nations as such. 'Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.'

The Silver Coffin of Ghengis Khan

Messages from Chungking state that the remains of Ghengis Khan, which were removed from Inner Mongolia in June, in order to prevent them from being seized by the Japanese, are now lying in State in the ancient temple of Dragon Hill, thirty miles from Lanchow, where they are guarded by Mongol Lamas and soldiers who escorted the silver coffin to China.

Ghengis Khan is regarded in Europe as a military scourge and a destroyer of civilization, but his genius for war is still venerated in Mongolia. He was born in 1162 and died in 1227.
